

CALIFORNIA JURORS.—We notice among the deaths in California that of Mr. Jacob App, son of Leonard App of Selinsgrove, Union county, aged about 24 years, in October last. Mr. App, whose lungs were affected, found his health so much improved in his Mexican campaign, that he concluded to leave the abundance of his father's house to visit California by the overland route, and died soon after his arrival. The climate and bleak winds of California are not adapted for consumption.

FROM CALIFORNIA.—The Empire City has arrived from California with a half a million of dollars. The constitution was adopted and Peter H. Burnett elected Governor. Mr. Gwin and Col. Fremont will most probably be the U. S. Senators.

Our Danville contemporaries are disputing about the politics of Mr. Charles Gearhart who was lately arrested for robbing the Post Office, at that place. Poor Charley! a few months since he could easily have "defined his position" but now "there are none so low as to do him reverence."

The Pennsylvania Legislature will meet on the first Tuesday of January. The Governors Message will probably not be read until Wednesday.

BANK OF DANVILLE.

The temporary Banking House for this institution is so far completed as to be ready for use, and on Tuesday last the Directors met in the room prepared for their use, and proceeded to the election of a Cashier and Clerk, whereupon Geo. A. Frick, Esq., of Danville, was elected Cashier, and David Clark, Esq., of Catawissa, Clerk. On the final ballot, we understand Mr. Frick had 9 out of the 13 votes, he himself voting for another candidate for Cashier. Mr. Clark had 11 votes on the final ballot for Clerk.

Mr. Balby, the President of the Bank, has received specimens of the \$5, \$20, \$50, and \$100 notes, some of which contain views of our iron works, and the town, creditable to the artists engaged in getting up the plates. In a few weeks more, the Bank will be ready for the transaction of business, and we have an abiding faith that it will be so conducted as to establish a credit and a good name for the institution, equal to that of any country Bank in Pennsylvania.—Danville Intelligencer.
