Truth is Mighty, and Must Prevail. Report of the Committee appointed to superintend the Burning of the Iron Safes, at Reading, February 27, 1857.

The undersigned, members of the committee, do respectfully report, that we saw two Safes originally agreed upon by Farrel & Herring and Evans & Watson, placed side by side in a furnace, viz: The Safe in use by the Paymaster of the Philadelphia and Reading Railroad Company.

The fire was started at 8 1/2 o'clock, A. M., and kept up until four o'clock of the next day, two cords of oak and half chestnut wood were entirely consumed, the whole under the superintendance of the subscribers, members of the Committee.
