ANOTHER SAN ATTRACTION.—We regret to inform our readers, that a painful dispute arose, on Tuesday night about 9 o'clock, between Daniel M. The wound was examined by Dr. Hobin, but he was unable to extract the ball. The injury is considered very serious, and it is feared will prove fatal, as hemorrhage of the lungs has continued ever since he was shot. Kasher was arrested, and had a hearing before Esq. Caldwell, who committed him to jail to await the result of Taly's injuries. There are extremely circumstances, it is alleged by Kasher's friends, that can be adduced in his favor, so that till there is a further legal hearing we know any more. He is a returned soldier, and when wounded is represented as a kind and peaceable man.—Shamokin Herald.
