BAGGAGE CAR CHECKED.—On Sunday morning last, about 4 o'clock, a serious accident occurred to the Erie Express Train at Chillisquepa, a mile or so below Lewisburg station. By some accident, as yet unexplained, the baggage car caught fire and was totally consumed, together with all the baggage of the passengers. The train was stopped, and the locomotive and other cars separated from the one which was on fire, and in this way no damage was sustained by the passengers, nor were the other cars injured. The amount of loss is unknown.

Be it Enacted by the Burgess and Common Councilmen of the Borough of Sunbury, and it is the duty of the Burgess and Councilmen, that if any person or persons, within the limits of the Borough, aforesaid, become intoxicated and disorderly, disturbing the peace, or committing any offense, the Chief Burgess of the said Borough, and he is hereby authorized, at his own view, or information being made before him, to issue a warrant to arrest and bring before him, and upon conviction of any such offense, to fine and pay such fine as may be imposed by the Chief Burgess of said Borough, not exceeding twenty dollars, for the use of said Borough, and any person or persons neglecting, or refusing to pay the same, with costs of suit, the Chief Burgess is hereby authorized to commit such person or persons to the county jail for each offense, for any period not exceeding thirty days.
