TREATMENT OF APPLE TREES.—The best of us are not thoughtful. It is not long since we gave a report of the Pennsylvania Fruit Growers' Society, in which appeared some common-sense views in regard to the treatment of apple trees; but it is a chance that most who have read it have not forgotten it. It will do no harm however to repeat the substance of what was said.
In the first place the tree is much weakened by the apple-borer. These nasty things must be kept out of the tree, and the year, and kept out of the future. They enter the tree only at the surface of the ground, and an examination will now tell whether they are there or not; but our experience of trees about here is that they are pretty sure to be. If there is a saw-dust sort of matter on the tree, it is the work of the borer. The grub has ejected in their boring operations. If within, make an unceremonious call on them with a piece of wire. It need not be thrust in tenderly. After it comes tolerably certain that the wire has made the acquaintance of each of these fat offenders, the next thing to do is to see that no more are permitted to enter. The convention speakers say, what we have long said before them, that paper wrapped around the stem just under the ground, and just above, and then gas-lar-pole, (but it is better without the tar fume) in February or early in March, will accomplish this. This is very easily tried, and they who do not think it worth while deserve no apples.
This borer business being disposed of, a little feeding is the next thing in order. Very rich earth put on the surface seems to benefit the tree. In Montgomery county last year we saw trees thriving wonderfully on ashes spread several inches thick under the trees. Then ashes are often filled with kitchen refuse, and probably the fertilizing property lies much in these and not in the ashes themselves.
Then another trouble from the codling moth; but it appears that a little labor in emptying bottles once a day does much to remove this. The bottles are filled with molasses and vinegar, and we have the testimony of President Schneider—about the best of living evidence by the way—that thousands are destroyed in this manner.
This is the season to think of these things; and that people may think is the reason we give these notes though somewhat repeating what has so recently been said.—*Germanian Telegraph.*
PRUNING FRUIT TREES.—On this subject, important to every fruit grower, we give the following seasonable advice by an old fruit grower. He says that he has been engaged in cultivating trees for the past twenty years, and has pruned apple and pear trees every month in the year, and he is confident always have the time to spare would prefer pruning in the month of June, for the following reasons:
"First, the wound made by the removal of a branch at this season will heal sooner than one made at any other time of the year. Second, very few water sprouts will grow after pruning, and the fruit which remains will be larger in consequence. Any person who is at all acquainted with the management of fruit trees, knows that if a tree is pruned in June the wound will heal in a very short time. To prune in June, persons should wear rubber or other soft shoes, to prevent barking the branches. My reason for pruning in the spring are, we generally have high winds and cold showers, the winds dry and crack the new wood, and the rain enters and breaks it, which it does not do in June. Water sprouts will also grow, which will be trimmed off every season. You can save your trees from winter injury, or was; but every farmer does not always have these materials at hand, and in June they are not used."
TREE SUFFERING.—The sunflower is useful for many purposes. There is no quick as that of the sunflower. It will speedily cure colds, coughs and cramps. It is the best thing ever fed to horses to give their hair a bright and glossy appearance; and given to a famished horse will give immediate relief. Give a horse a quart of sunflower oil at each feeding, and he will never founder. The stalk also makes a very good substitute for bean-pods while growing.
Use judgment in selecting your assortment of flower-seed, and secure a succession of bloom and a variety of colors throughout the season. A large assortment of white flowers is very desirable for bouquets. The white Verbena, Petunias, Carnations, Camellia and Alyssum are very desirable for small bouquets.
Recipes, &c.
RICHARD PIE.—Prepare the stalks by peeling of the thin, reddish skin, and cutting in half or three-quarter-inch pieces, which spread evenly in your crust-lined tins. Sprinkle with a little flour, to which add a bit of butter and a teaspoon of sugar, if for a pie. However, when it is large, use a little more sugar, or when a very sharp sour taste is not relished, a pinch of soda may be used to advantage, with less sugar, as it goes far toward neutralizing the acid. (We would here add: save all your surplus pie-plant, prepare for use, and dry in the sun, and use in tarts, puddings, &c. Soak and stew for winter use, with sugar and soda as above for pies. It makes also a nice sauce for tea.)
LEMON PIE.—Take two lemons, four eggs, two spoonfuls melted butter, eight spoonfuls sugar; squeeze the juice of both lemons, and grate the rind of one. Stir together the yolks, sugar, butter, juice and rind. Cover a plate with pastry, pour the mixture in, and bake till crust is done. Then beat the whites of the eggs to a stiff froth, stir into it four spoonfuls sugar, put it on the pie, and set it back into the oven for a delicate browning. This is for two company-sized pies.
HAM TOAST.—Chop some lean ham, put in a pan with a little pepper, a lump of butter and two eggs beaten; when heated through, spread it on buttered toast and serve hot.
TO KEEP HAMS IN SUMMER.—Cut in slices and trim off the rind and outside; fry it about half an inch, you would fry a little fruit, and pack tightly in jars; pour over it the fat that has been fried out of it, close the jar tight, set it in a cool place, and when used, give it a second frying before serving up.
"EVERY-DAY" PUDDING.—Half a loaf of stale bread soaked in a quart of milk; four eggs, four tablespoonfuls of flour; a little fruit, and sugar, finely powdered. Steam or boil three-fourths of an hour. Serve with the following sauce:
FISH FATTERS.—Take the remains of any fish which has been served the preceding day, remove all the bones, roll or mash it well. Mix together half a tea-spoonful of sweet cream with two well-beaten eggs, anchovy sauce and pepper; mix equal quantities—enough to make a proper consistency, cut or mould into small cakes and fry in butter or lard.
LEMON FOR A COUGH.—Roast the lemon very carefully without burning it; when it is hot, cut and squeeze into a cup upon three ounces of sugar, finely powdered. Take a spoonful when ever your cough troubles you. It is good and agreeable to the taste. Hardly has it been known to fail of giving relief.
