

DEATH OF GOVERNOR GEARY. Ex-Governor JOHN W. GEARY died suddenly and unexpectedly at his residence in Harrisburg on Saturday last.

JOHN W. GEARY was born near Mount Pleasant, Westmoreland county, in 1819. His life was a model of industry and industry.
