MAINE REPLIES TO VERMONT.

STONINGTON, Sept. 12, 1876.

This has been another stormy day, and to-night the storm continues with increased violence. Reports from all over the State indicate that property is being blown over the country. The State of Vermont is now in the hands of the Missouri River and streams tributary to it have been carried away. Hay stacked in bottom lands has been swept away or destroyed. All the streams in the upper Missouri country are over their banks. Such a flood in this season of the year was never before known. On Saturday the rainfall at Forts Randall and Sully was four inches.

THE VOICE OF THE PINE TREE STATE.

A Clean Sweep for Hayes and Wheeler.

Portland, September 12.—The vote of Maine this year is the largest ever cast, and the Republicans have swept the State by 15,000 majority. Every Congressional District has gone Republican, and our candidate for Governor has a majority in every county in the State. The Republican can count on success in every one of all the counties but two; one county which the Democrats have held for several years has been redeemed. Twenty-nine out of thirty-one State Senators are Republican as are four-fifths of the Representatives, to the State Legislature. Governor Hayes will receive the electoral vote of Maine by a majority of 20,000 to 25,000.

SERIOUS RAILROAD ACCIDENT.

TWO TRAINS THROWN FROM THE TRACK AND FOUR MEN INJURED.

TORRENSDALE, September 14.—A serious accident occurred yesterday morning at Torrensdales on the Pennsylvania railroad. While the 330 A. M. train from Philadelphia, going north, passed a freight train which was standing on a side track, two cows became wedged in between the trains and threw the passenger train from the track. The mail car was thrown off its tracks and upset, the baggage car was thrown over an embankment six feet high, and a passenger car was telescoped and badly wrecked. The mail and Adams Express cars were smashed to pieces. Clement Jones, the mail agent, was hurt about the head and received dangerous internal injuries. He was taken to the convent near by. G. W. Hyde, through baggage master, was badly hurt in the groin and hip, and A. E. Hoover, Mail Agent was bruised about the body, and badly cut in the forehead. Capt. A. D. Herber, sleeping car conductor, was also bruised about the body. Engineer Van Arsdale put on steam and drove ahead, thus saving the cars from further damage. Most of the damage would have been averted had not the engine broke its coupling.

THE MINNESOTA BANLITS.

ST. PAUL, September 12.—Gov. Pillsbury has issued a proclamation offering a reward of \$1,000 each for the capture of the bandits engaged in the Northfield affair. This is in lieu of the reward of \$1,500 heretofore offered for the capture of the entire band. The National bank at Northfield has also increased its reward to \$500 each. A special dispatch to the Pioneer Press from Waterville says the horses and saddles of the robbers were found this afternoon in the woods near Cleveland, on the Waterville road. This is accepted by some as evidence that the robbers have escaped through the cordons of their pursuers, and many of the latter are going home. A number remain, however, and are still scouring the country. The Sheriff of Fairbairn County reports seeing five men near Indian Lake, five miles from Mankato, this afternoon who bore out the description of the robbers, and a force of men has gone in pursuit. The officials of various railroads have been notified to be on their guard.

TWO MEN SHOT BY A RIFMAN.

WASHINGTON, September 13.—About one o'clock this morning Leon Wood, a notorious rough, went to shoot Charles Goodman, a bar tender, who was a difficulty with Wood about two months ago. He fired three shots, two of which he effected on Goodman, one of them fracturing his arm so that amputation will be necessary. The third shot struck the happy puppy troupe, who had just entered the bar. The man who had just raised his rifle to his breast when the shot was fired, the ball passing entirely through and shattering his hand and striking his breast bone in a special condition. It will be some weeks before he will be able to resume his place in the troupe.

A Tramp Shot and Killed.

St. Louis, September 14.—Deanis Connor, watchman in the Chicago and Alton railroad yards, East St. Louis, discovered several tramps curled up in a freight car containing merchandise. He ordered them to get up, but they were missing, but they made a dash, got outside, and started to run. He called on them to halt or he would shoot. One of them being paid to his command he shot one through the heart killing him instantly. Another was captured. He said they came down from Alton in the car, but had no intention of stealing anything. The coroner's jury just returned on the case, and he was released from custody.

Highway Robbery.

Mr. R. J. Workman, of Springfield township, Fayette county, Pa., was knocked down a few days ago by an unknown man and robbed of \$800. The outrage occurred near Workman's own house. His assailant was lying in wait for him, whom he no doubt knew if being in funds, and while taking a stroll only a short distance from his own door he was violently assailed and robbed before he had time to comprehend his condition, not being made aware of the approach by the robbers until they were upon him, one by one, save by the crashing of the break and undergrowth. One blow from the villain leveled him to the ground, and the fellow's object was too easily accomplished. The robber held a pistol to his head and swore that if he said a word he would blow his brains out. It is rather singular that Mr. Workman should carry such a large sum of money about his person.
