 There were few, very few, cases of drunk and disorderly on Christmas.

 The court has issued a decree giving each ward in Johnstown one school director.

 Judge Simonton and McPherson, before whom the South Pennsylvania case was argued, have set Tuesday, January 5th, as the time for disposing of the case now before the Supreme Court.  
 A number of the members of the bar met at the Abitration room in the Court House on Wednesday evening, Dec. 23d, for the purpose of forming a "Somerset County Bar Association." Seventeen persons were present. A committee of seven was appointed, and they will meet on the 30th of December to meet at the call of the President.  
 One of the pleasant things of Christmas day was a family reunion at the residence of Mr. W. B. Croft on Patriot street. Covers were laid at 26 at the dinner table. The only member of the family absent was one of the sons-in-law, Mr. Marshall Hottel, who was detained at his home in Pottsville on the important business. It was a merry family party and the first time they had all met together in a number of years.  
 Superintendent Walter, in order to give teachers and others at a distance, the same chance to secure good seats for the lecture as those living at the county seat, caused it to be announced that no tickets would be sold until Christmas morning. As early as 6:30 Christmas morning parties were on hand to purchase tickets, and by noon all the best seats were sold. So great was the rush that on Monday Prof. Weller was compelled to add a couple of additional rows of seats in order to accommodate the people.

The Christmas Ship at the Disciple Church on the evening of Christmas was a decided success. The exercises consisted of a series of appropriate Christmas songs interspersed by recitations and alternate readings of appropriate prophecies and their fulfillment. During the singing of an appropriate song a large cart was slowly stripped naked and the fire, finely decorated and lighted and heavily laden ship, twenty-one feet long, seemed to be sailing into port. Every inch of sitting and standing room in the large auditorium, the aisles, and the gallery and vestibule was taken up, and at least as many more filled to gain admittance.  
 Mr. Hugh B. Fitzpatrick was found dead in bed at the residence of John M. Barry, with whom he was in Lancaster city on Tuesday morning last. He had been suffocated by illuminating gas. It is supposed that he accidentally turned on the gas after extinguishing the light. The verdict of the coroner's jury was accidental death, due to Asphyxia. He was 43 years of age and had been engaged in railroad contract work all his life. His last work was on the Negro Mountain tunnel, 4 miles east of this place, in conjunction with Mr. Ed McGovern. Mr. Fitzpatrick had been in the city in the forenoon being at work on the tunnel, and will, it is believed, be buried in the afternoon.

The Pittsburgh Ledger gives its annual Snapshot of Somerset on Friday, January 1, 1920.  
 Another pretty burglary was committed in Somerset on Sunday. Some \$50 worth of jewelry forced their way into Mr. "Tocker" Plink's place on the corner of Union and Main streets by cutting out the glass in the transom over the door leading into the oyster room. The door to the store room was opened and a number of valuable articles were taken. The party evidently were hungry, for they ate or carried off all the sandwiches and nearly all the cakes and pies in the place. It took several gallons of cider to appease their thirst. This was the fourth year that the burglary has broken into within a month. A double barreled shot gun with a heavy charge of bird shot and a man that will weigh to pull the trigger should be put on guard.  
 The Pittsburgh Post-Gazette has this to say in regard to the Somerset County Railroad: Col. Richard Nevin, the Government Architect in Pittsburgh, has been appointed Superintendent of the Somerset County Railroad. The choice was made at a meeting of the directors of the company. P. and Max Schweibert, of March Chunk, well-known capitalists and railroad builders, were in the city yesterday in connection with the meeting. The result of the meeting was a determination to prosecute the construction of the road as rapidly and as early as possible. Col. Nevin will assume the duties of his position early in January in connection with his work on the Government work in this city. The line will be, when completed, twenty-two miles in length, and a narrow-gauge road. It begins at Drake's town Junction, near Confluence, and will extend to Somerset, twenty-two miles distant. Ten miles of the road has been completed, and only twelve miles remain to be built. The road will be a cut-off for the Pittsburgh branch of the Baltimore & Ohio from Somerset. It penetrates a country abounding in valuable timber, coal, fire-clay and other resources. One vein of fire-clay is seven feet thick, while the coal veins range from three to six feet in thickness. About 200,000 feet of white oak, hemlock, poplar, chestnut and other lumber are already shipped monthly to Baltimore, and thence to England.  
 Col. Xevion has been over the route of the extension and thinks it can be completed at a small cost. He is very much pleased with the line and thinks it will be a valuable feeder both to the Baltimore & Ohio and the city of Pittsburgh.

The service was something altogether new for Somerset and brought out an audience that taxed the capacity of the Church.
