A constable named Pierce repaired to South Des Moines with a warrant to search the premises of Nym Wyatt, who runs a billiard hall. His efforts were rewarded by the discovery of a small keg of beer in the cellar, which he seized and carried to the floor above. Here Mr. Wyatt took hold of the keg and attempted to recover possession of it, when Pierce drew a revolver on her. Harry Lloyd, employed upon the premises, struck down his arm. The two men then became engaged in a struggle, which did not end until they had tumbled out of doors and rolled down an embankment, the officer alighting uppermost, when he fired, following this with a terrific blow on the head with the revolver. The ball struck a rib and glanced, following it nearly to the spine, where it lodged and was extracted. The wound is probably fatal.
