St. Louis, April 23.—Special dispatches received here today give appalling details of the cyclone, tornado and hail storms.

The district devastated are a considerable part of Western and Southern Missouri, Southern Kansas and Northern Kansas.

In Bates and Vernon counties, Missouri, the destruction was very great. West and south of Rich Hill the storm raged with terrific violence.
