MINE EXPLOSION.

Wednesday, Feb. 2.—A fall of rock took place in the Nottingham shaft of the Lehigh and Wilkes-Barre Coal Company yesterday morning, which drove the accumulated gas into the gangways, where ten men had been at work with naked lamps, and an explosion soon followed. All the men were burned on the face, hands and body; Peter Helm was cut upon the head and his crown and hands badly burned; John Crossin, with his male, was buried beneath the falling rock; Wm. Roberts, a boy driver, is missing; John Humphreys, a miner, died while being removed from the mine; his body was burned to a crisp; Joseph Dunston, five boys, was burned on the face and hands; his injuries are said to be fatal; John Helm was fatally burned; John P. Thomas was burned in the face and hands; David Fox was seriously burned, and his recovery is doubtful; and Thomas Lake was slightly cut on the head. The fall of rock and coal cut off the way for five miles in the interior of the mine making repairs. Their names are John Crossin, David Williams, John Davis, Edward Morris and an unknown man. Efforts were promptly made to rescue them, though it was believed they were all dead.
