THE Constitution of the State, in sec tion 18, sets forth that "the General Assembly, immediately after each United States decennial census, shall apportion the State into Senatorial and Represen tative districts, agreeably to the provisions of sections 16 and 17." Section 1 reads as follows: "The State shall b divided into tifty Senatorial districts, o compact and contiguous territory, as nearly equal in population as may be and each district shall be entitled to one Senator. Each county containing one o more ratios of population shall be entitle to one or more Senator for each ratio and to an additional Senator for a surpl of population exceeding three-lifths of ratio, but no county shall form a separate district unless it skall contain four fifth of a ratio, except where the adjoining counties are each entitled to one or more Senators, when such county may be as signed a Senator on less than four-fifth and exceeding one-half a ratio; and no county shall be divided unless entitled to two or more Senators. No city or county shall be entitled to separate representation exceeding one sixth the whole number of Senators. No ward, 12 borough or township shall be divided in the formation of a district. 
