Graded County Schools. The School Directors' Association of Pennsylvania, recently organized in Harrisburg, has a measure in process of creation providing for the consolidation of schools in Pennsylvania. The measure is a bill to amend the act in relation to the public schools, and the next Legislature will be asked to pass it.
