Eligibility of Election Officers.
 In obedience to the requirements of said Act of Assembly, I also give notice that every person, excepting justices of the peace, who shall within two months, have held any office or appointment of profit or trust under the Government of the United States of this State or of any city or incorporated district, whether a commissioned officer or otherwise, a subordinate officer or agent who is or shall be employed under the Legislative, Executive or Judiciary Department of this State or of the United States or of any city or incorporated district, and also that every member of Congress and of the State Legislature and of the select or common council of any city or commissioners of non-incorporated district, is, by law, incapable of holding or exercising at the same time the office or appointment of Judge, Inspector, or Clerk of any Election of the Commonwealth, and that no Inspector, Judge or any other officer of any such election shall be eligible to any office to be then voted for, except that of an election officer.

List of Nominations as Certified by the Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and by the Commissioners of Somerset County, and to be voted for in the several Election Districts of said County at the ensuing election.

A Cross (X) at the Large Square at the Right of the Surnames of the Candidates for President and Vice-President at the Head of the Group of Presidential Electors shall be Equivalent to a Mark Opposite Every Name of the Group of Electors.
 A Cross (X) marked in the square at the right of the Name of Each Candidate inside the line enclosing the column Indicates a Vote for Each Candidate Thus Marked.
 If a Cross (X) be Marked Within the Circle at the Head of the Column it will be Equivalent to a Mark Opposite Every Name in the column. Those who do not desire to Vote a Straight Ticket must Not Mark a cross within the circle at the head of the column.
