Lumbermen's Meeting.

In pursuance of a call issued by parties opposed to the Clarion River Navigation Company, there was a meeting held at Strattonville, Clarion Co., on Tuesday, 13th of August.

The meeting was called to order, whereupon James W. Guthrie, of Strattonville was elected Chairman and T. B. Cobb, of Tionesta, Secretary.

An Executive Committee of seven members was then elected, who retired for the purpose of forming a permanent organization, and constitution governing the same.

During the absence of the committee the meeting listened to remarks from different gentlemen, pertaining to the history of the charter of the Clarion River Navigation Co., and the practical working of the so-called improvements made under said charter.

Art. 1. This association shall be known as the Clarion River Lumbermen's Protective Union.

ness on said stream below Raught's Mills, who receive no benefit from the alleged improvements of the Corporation, but believe them to be no other than a public nuisance, and that the same should be abated, we the undersigned hereby agree, and pledge ourselves to adopt every legal means to obtain a Repeal of the Charter of said Corporation, and to protect each and every member of this association who is engaged in the lumbering business below Raught's Mills, against the collection of any tolls by the said Clarion River Navigation Company.

Art. 4. The fee for membership in this Association shall be two dollars, and the Executive Committee shall have full power to assess members, pro rata, according to the amount of lumber or boats which each member controls, with a sufficient tax to meet the expenses of this Association, from time to time as in their payment the same may be needed.

Art. 5. The Treasurer is empowered to collect said tax when assessed. Art. 6. All moneys in hands at the Treasurer shall be disbursed by him, only upon an order drawn on him by the President and Secretary of this Association, countersigned by the Pres't and Sec'y of the Executive Committee.

Art. 7. The present Executive Committee shall be permanent, and have full power to transact all business intended to carry out the spirit and intention of this Association. Each article was noted upon separately, and all were duly adopted. The following gentlemen were then duly elected officers of the association: D. B. Watson Esq., of Scotch Hill, President; T. W. Taylor, of Blyson, Vice President; Jeremiah Cook, of Cooksburg, Treasurer; T. B. Cobb, of Tionesta, Secretary.

The proceedings of this meeting were then ordered to be published in the papers of Elk, Jefferson, Forest and Clarion counties.

It was further ordered that the Secretary provide fifty printed copies of the Constitution for use of the present members of the association in obtaining additional members.

The meeting was enthusiastic, and entirely harmonious, all being determined to take all legal means to obtain relief from the unjust action of the Clarion River Navigation Company towards lumbermen doing business on the stream below Raught's Mills.

The meeting adjourned at six P. M. subject to the call of the President, D. B. Watson, Esq.

Coming Elections. Previous to the great Presidential contest in November, the following States and Territories will hold elections for State and Legislative officers: New Mexico, September 1. California, September 2. Vermont, September 3. Maine, September 9. Colorado Territory, September 10. Dakota, Indiana, Iowa, Nebraska, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and District of Columbia, October 8. South Carolina, October 16. West Virginia, October 24.

All the States vote for Presidential electors on the 5th of November, and on the same day the following choose State officers: Arkansas, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, Tennessee, Virginia and Wisconsin. Arizona holds her territorial election on the 8th of November.

It should be stated in reference to the West Virginia election, the people of that State vote on the adoption or rejection of a new constitution on the 22d of the present month, and the general State election is to be held at the same time. If the constitution shall be ratified, the October election which would otherwise come on the 24th, will be dispensed with. If rejected, the August election will go for naught, and the October election will be held as usual.
