#### PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF PENNSYLVA-

Joint resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Pennsylvania.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the following amendment of the Con-stitution of this Commonwealth be pro-posed to the people for thheir adoption or rejection, pursuant to the provisions of the tenth article thereof, to-wit:

AMENDMENT:
Strike out the sixth section of the sixth article of the Constitution, and insert in lieu thereof the following: "A State Treasurer shall be chosen by the qualified electors of the State, at such times and for such term of service as shall be prescribed by law."
