DEATH OF OAKES AXIS.

NORTH EASTON, May 8. Mr. Ames was 69 years 3 months and 18 days old at the time of his death. He has been suffering from diabetes for nearly three years, but by attention to diet has been able to keep the disease in check.

On Monday of last week, Thursday he remained at home, occasionally visiting his office at North Easton. Thursday evening he was seized with inflammation in the diaphragm, and through the night he suffered intense pain, obtaining no sleep.

On Friday he obtained a little rest while in a sitting posture. He passed the day sitting in a chair. Saturday he was more comfortable. Sunday he slept well. Monday his pulse and the temperature of his body and perspiration all indicated a rapid return to his usual health.

On Tuesday he was seized with apoplexy, resulting in paralysis of the right side of the body. At the same time slight indications of pneumonia in the lower left lung.

On Wednesday he remained partially conscious at intervals up to noon Wednesday, since which he has remained perfectly unconscious.
