We clip the following particulars from the Elk Democrat, of a terrible accident at Blue Rock, Jefferson county, on Thursday of last week:

Two men named Nathan Perry and Edward Rynear were stationed at the foot of a slide on the job of W. T. Lane, for the purpose of removing the logs from the mouth of the slide, to prevent the logs from jamming. About four o'clock a log which would scale from four to five hundred feet struck something in its descent when near the foot of the slide with such force as to jump it entirely out. In its mad career it struck the top of a stump, which changed its course and hurled it broadside in the direction of the men with fearful velocity. H. K. Lane, who was some distance up the slide, saw them both turn and run, but without avail, as the log struck them in the region of the head, killing them both instantly.
