As is known to every surveyor the magnetic needle does not point directly north and south, but makes an angle of about 3° in this locality with the true meridian or north and south line, such as is intended above. There are only rare instances that two needles will indicate the same direction.

A good deal of vexation and litigation can thus be avoided and at an expense many times less than would conclude a single suit over disputed lands. After careful investigation and patient labor and research on various bodies of lands in this county I am convinced that such would be a profitable investment for the County Commissioners to make, and at the same time be doing nothing more than their duty, and also carrying out the Act of 1850 requiring such line to be established in each county of this Commonwealth.

This is my opinion of the matter and I should like to hear the views of others, and give the subject a thorough discussion through the press of the county if the editors will allow the space. Old land marks are fast disappearing, and our lands are becoming more and more valuable, and greater care and better methods should be adopted to insure the best results in the subdivisions of the original warrants and perpetuations of "corners" than has heretofore existed.
