SENATOR EDMUNDS, of Vermont, has introduced more bills of a general practical character than any other five members of the Senate. The country could ill afford to lose such a man from Congress to bury him in the United States Supreme Court.

A New York dispatch says: General Hancock approves and promulgates in a general order the sentence of Sergeant John A. Mason, who attempted to shoot Guiteau. He is condemned by the court martial to be dishonorably discharged from the army with the loss of all pay and allowances and to be confined at hard labor in a penitentiary for eight years. The penitentiary at Albany is designated as the place, subject to the approval of the Secretary of War.

THE Republicans of Jefferson county have instructed their delegates to the State Convention to vote for the one-legged veteran of Centre county, for Governor, and Major A. M. Brown of Allegheny for Supreme Judge. General Beaver is the coming Governor of Pennsylvania if the wishes of the Republican voters is consulted, bosses, independents, kickers, &c., to the contrary notwithstanding. He is the people's man and the fittest in Pennsylvania to-day for the position.

It is a fact which deserves more than a passing notice that the Mormons are not in the least disturbed by the intense feeling of opposition which has been excited in all parts of the country to polygamy, and they take no notice whatever of the bill now before Congress for the suppression of that institution, and the admission of Utah as a State. Indeed, the Legislature of Utah, which is largely Mormon, has taken all the preliminary steps which is necessary for it in view of the admission of the Territory into the Union. There is a deliberation and coolness in this which indicate the close organization of Mormonism as a Church and a community, and the resolution with which the Mormon people intend to defend their homes and their wives, particularly the latter.
