INDUSTRIOUS REFORMERS.

The present Legislature of Pennsylvania deserves great credit for industry and good intentions. Of course we speak of the Legislature generally, and not of the obstructionists, who seem disposed to put in their allotted time, draw their money and go home without affecting any good purpose.

The above editorial from the Crawford Democrat reads like a tale from the Arabian Nights or a fragment of testimony in the Star Route trial to anyone familiar with the course of events since the Legislature met at Harrisburg three months ago.

Will the editor of the Democrat please mention the important legislation that has originated in the democratic branch of the legislature? The perfect accord between the Governor and majority in the House has been illustrated on more than one occasion.

The Governor has shown his appreciation of the statesmanship of the reformers at Harrisburg by vetoing about one-half the bills passed by them. The republican minority in the House are not following the tactics of the democrats in Congress, nor can the Democrat point out a single instance since the Legislature met where they have acted in the character of obstructionists.

The democrats soon found to their disgust that the republicans were ready and willing to support any and every true reform measure proposed. In this dilemma the democratic majority in the House conceived the brilliant idea of doing nothing and blaming it on republican obstruction; but it will not avail them.
