A CONTEMPORARY has had one of its staff in Washington taking an account of stock, and he reports the Morrison tariff bill as dead. It may be dead as to any probability of its passage, but it will live a great deal longer in its consequences than its promoters will be pleased with. While the question of free trade was one to read about in the lucubration of the theoretical essayists of the schools it captured the imagination of the speculative, and seemed to make some headway among those who were given to mysticism. But when the meeting of a Democratic Congress and the election of a free trade speaker encouraged the Morrisons to bring the country face to face with the actual adoption of a free trade tariff, all these people were constrained to look at the effect it would have on their actual every day lives. The farmer might be brought to grow about the apparent burden imposed upon him in the price of his cloth, machinery, &c., but when he is confronted with the fact that free trade involves the striking off the duties upon products which come into immediate competition with his own, he gets a rather different idea of what free trade means. So it is with all the interests affected by the tariff policy. The discussion which the movement has forced upon the country has opened the minds of a great many who never thought much about the subject, and those who were instrumental in bringing it about will have to reckon with these classes in the future. It does not look rosy for Democracy.
