FOOD SALARIES.

The Capitol at Washington was struck by lightning the other day, but Free Trader Mills paid no attention whatever to the warning.

WHERE THE ANSWER WILL COME FROM.—"What shall I say of a tariff for protection?" said the Hon. Frank Hurd at a meeting in St. Paul last Saturday night.

CHIEF JUSTICE WAITE, of the U. S. Supreme Court, died suddenly of pneumonia on Friday morning last.

The discussion of a successor to the late Chief Justice Waite has already begun, and in this connection the Philadelphia Press offers the following suggestion:

The editor of the Philadelphia Press, Mr. Chas. Emory Smith who is now in Washington, writes as follows to his paper of the impending danger which threatens the country in the passage of the Mills tariff bill.

It is high time the country should wake up to the real gravity of the tariff situation. No alarm has been felt through the land because nobody away from the capital has supposed there was any serious danger that the Mills bill or anything like it could pass.

There has been a false sense of security because there has been a false idea of the possibilities. We have all treated the Mills bill as a great wrong but not as an imminent menace.

We must now face and fight it not merely as an attempted iniquity but as an immediate peril. It may as well be understood at once that there is real danger that this bill, somewhat modified, may pass the House and that a desperate effort will be made to force it through the Senate.

A careful and not hasty survey here on the ground discloses risks and threatenings that have not been appreciated at a distance. The question has its bearings both industrially and politically, and all concerned will realize the difference between confronting an attack when it is a remote hazard and when it is an impending probability.
