Col. J. C. BONNER of Toledo, was at the Ebbitt House, Washington, D. C., last week. Colonel Bonner is engaged in the manufacture of brushes in Toledo. The McKinley law raised the duty on brushes from 30 per cent. to 40 per cent. Mr. Bonner was asked how the change had affected his business. "Under the 10 per cent. increase of duty," he said, "we have enlarged our facilities and are sending to all parts of the country a grade of brushes which we did not attempt to make under the former duty at all. The Mills bill proposed to reduce the duty on brushes to 20 per cent. Had this been done it would, without any doubt or room for dispute, have proved the ruin of the business of brush manufacturing in this country."
