

### PENROSE IS BUSY Pennsylvania's Young Senator Occupied With Official Works

#### MANY CHATS WITH ROOSEVELT

He Is a Frequent Visitor at the White House and Secms to De Close In the Confidence of the President On Administration Plans. (Special Correspondence)

Philodelphia, Dec. 24 -- United States Senator Fenroise is at home spending the holidays, but he has had little opportunity to Indulgo in social funccommittee work which is engaging his entire vacation period. The most important questions that will come before congress at this sersion will first have to be considered by the committoo of which Senator Penrose is a member, and on several of these committees the bulk of the work has devolvel upon him.

IMPORTANT COMMITTEE WORK As chairman of the committee on immigration, Senator Penrose will have to grapple with several of the most serious problems which confront the American paople. He has been in frequent consultation with Chief Powlerly, of the immigration bureau, and has a fund of statistics regarding immigration and the effect of the indisriminate importation of uneducated and undesirable foreigners upon the condition of American labor. Lead-LADIES Extra heavy extensi n ers of labor organizations throughout the Union have been in correspondence with Senator Penrose and he proposes to do everything in his power to protect the interests of citizens of the United States against the corporations which have been instrumental in bringing to this country the most objection-able class of foreigners.

Senster Penrose has been retained on the committees on naval affairs, commerce, coast and harbor defenses, education, post offices and post roads, uniforal banks and organization, conduct and expenditures of the executive department. In this latter capacity he is necessarily brought in close official relations with President Roossvalt and members of his cubinet. Every one of


