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UNCLE SAM'S NEW CRUISER.

The St. Louis, Sister Ship to the Milwaukee, Launched at Philadelphia. Philadelphia, May 8.—The protected cruiser St. Louis was launched at the Neafie & Levy shipyard.

The St. Louis is a sister ship to the Milwaukee, now building at San Francisco, and the Charleston, in course of construction at Newport News.

The St. Louis is in a higher state of completion previous to launching than any similar vessel built in the Eastern shipyard, being 77 per cent completed.

SPEAR IN HIS CELL. Former Cashier of Oberlin Bank Intends to Be Model Prisoner.

Columbus, O., May 8.—A. B. Spear, late cashier of the Oberlin National bank, was received at the penitentiary Saturday morning to enter upon his seven-year imprisonment.

Because there are now 10 bankers in the penitentiary, all of whom have been assigned to clerical work, it is not likely that Spear will be given an easy task at once.

GREENVILLE REJOICES. Steel Corporation Will Rebuild and Enlarge Hoop Plant.

Greenville, Pa., May 8.—General Superintendent I. W. Jenks of the American Steel Hoop company arrived from New York and announced that the steel corporation had authorized the rebuilding of the Greenville rolling mill and addition of a new modern mill.

Ground was staked off for the new buildings last week and work will be started at once.

It was stated that the petition signed by every business man in Greenville with two exceptions, pledging support to the Carnegie company when they started the local plant on an open shop basis two months ago, had weight with the steel corporation in authorizing the improvements.
