Tragic Event During Street Parade of Cole Bros' Circus.

Buffalo, June 11.—During the progress of Cole Bros' circus up Main street yesterday an Italian boy, later identified as Raphael Laquino, was crushed beneath the huge foot of one of the elephants and died a half hour later at a hospital.

Laquino was standing at the curb beside a pile of dirt in the middle of the block, in front of Lafayette square, and almost directly in front of the monument.

The animal was swinging his huge trunk, and as it swung from left to right it struck the boy, knocking him around to the right side and to the pavement underneath the elephant's body.

Another instant the right hind foot of the elephant landed upon the boy, terribly crushing his chest and the right side of his head.

The elephants were marching "lock step" as it were. The second elephant had hold of the first elephant's tail with his trunk, all of the animals being "connected" in this way.
