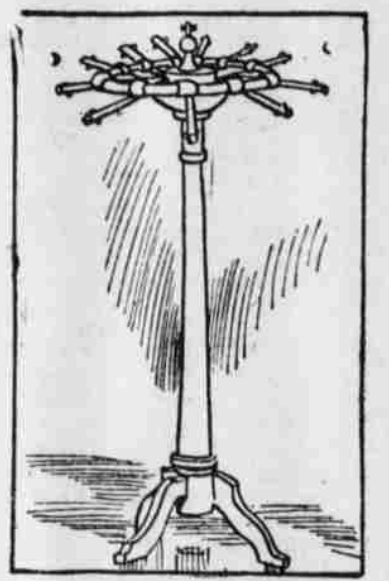
USE FOR OLD WASHSTANDS.
