### NURSE SACRIFICES HER LIFE

Takes Scarlet Fever Case to Save Herself From Ejectment.

New Haven, May 2.—Miss Grace Jeal, a nurse, was praised by clergymen as a martyr to duty in a pathetic case. She was recently graduated without funds, and, not obtaining a case promptly, was in danger of being ejected from her boarding place, when a scarlet fever case in a Jefferson street tenement house was offered her.

She knew the risk she ran and braved it. Being compelled to occupy the same room as the patient, she contracted the disease and died from it.

She had no known relatives, and her body would have been consigned for dissection to the Yale medical school but for the action of nurses in Grace hospital, who subscribed money to pay for a grave and funeral expenses.

Her trunk is still held at her boarding house for unpaid board. Her case is being used to arouse public sentiment in favor of a contagious disease hospital for the city.
