TRIVIAL HURTS FATAL

Aged Man and Young Girl Victims of Slight Accidents.

Two persons are dead in Latrobe, Pa. as the result of trivial accidents. M. L. Tansold, aged sixty, president of the Unity township school board, is one of the victims. His left knee was slightly bruised when he was thrown from a buggy by a runaway colt. Complications set in which resulted in his death.

Thelma Palmer, aged seven, daughter of Emmett Palmer of Oak avenue, Latrobe, died from blood poisoning resulting from a wound in a finger on her left hand caused by a splinter a week ago. The injury was so trivial at first that the child did not know when it occurred.

To Teach Sign Painting in School. In addition to manual training for the boys and domestic science for the girls, the city school board of Altoona, Pa. has decided to establish a course in sign painting for all pupils of the high school.

Girl Dies of Hurts. Ruth Cook, aged eighteen, of near New Castle, Pa. is dead as the result of injuries received in a buggy accident. Her sister Martha, twenty-three, is in a serious condition.

MINERS TO GO BACK SOON

Coal River (W. Va.) District Will Be Active Again.

After being on strike for four months 3,000 coal miners will return to work in the Coal River (W. Va.) mining district within a week, according to a statement made by "Mother" Jones. "This fight has just started," she said. "We realize that we cannot get everything we want just when we want it. The miners will return to work in the same manner as those who returned to work some days ago at the Dorothy mines."

Family Feared Dynamite. Peter Massing, a farmer of near Pittsburg, was committed to jail accused of having made threats to dynamite his wife and several children.

Lives Two Years With Broken Back. After living for over two years with a fractured spine John Gretskey, aged thirty-three, died in the St. Francis hospital, Pittsburg.

1,600 Miners on Strike. Sixteen hundred employees of the Panoast colliery of the Scranton Coal company at Throop, Pa. are out on strike.
