Our Receipt for Curing Measles.

To one gallon of water, take one and one-half lbs. of salt, one-third lb of sugar, one-half oz. of saltpetre, one-half oz. of potash. In this ratio the pickle to be increased to any quantity desired. Let these be boiled together, until all the salt has dissolved. Then throw it into a cool place, and when cold, pour it over your beef or pork, to remain a day or two, and then wash it with clean water, and dry it in the sun. The meat must be well covered with pickle, and should not be put down for a day or two after killing, during which time it should be slightly sprinkled with salt. The pickle, which remains in the meat, should be clear. Some omit boiling the pickle, and find it to be better, though the operation of boiling purifies the pickle by throwing off the dirt always to be found in salt and sugar.

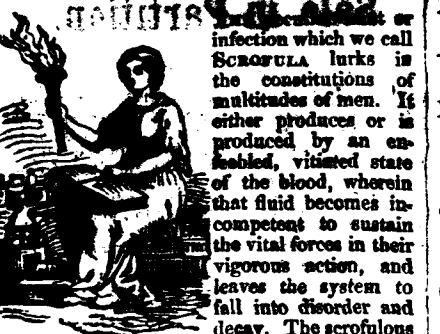
