Woman's Rights.

The indefatigable co-workers in this cause have been before the Assembly Committee again this session, with a strong and overwhelming petition for a recognition of, and action upon the question of Woman's Rights. The remarks made before that Committee were worthy the best head of the Legislature, and the earnest, and honest consideration of the Assembled Legislators. There is one thing clear—if no woman have any rights which they can conclusively make appear, from their constitution, and social relations, as intelligent, accountable beings to government and its laws, that belong to them, and which they do not now enjoy, why our legislators can do no less—and do honorably and justly—than to grant them. If ill advised laws bring misery, and unhappiness upon her as well as man, and good ones dispense to her the same blessing of peace, contentment and liberty as to man; and the infringement of any law brings upon her the same penalty attached to the transgression by man, and obedience the same fruits of property, and quietude—if she suffer and enjoy from the same causes which man suffers and enjoys from; if right—political and moral—be with her equally a right, and wrong equally a wrong with man; and if she be equally as capable of judging, of reasoning, and feeling on all these points, with man, why are not her rights, moral, social, and political equal, and the same with those of man? We think, and so does every man who thinks above his prejudices,—that woman is possessed of a nicest sense of moral obligation than man—she is more certain to be right, and act right upon all questions of momentous moral import. Man is swayed by his selfish interest from the high ground of a rational conscientious conviction. His principles, if they be ever so good, and commendable, will not stand against the promise of personal emolument. Woman on the contrary, is always faithful to her duty, where community of mankind are interested. In deciding upon the right and wrong of questions, there is a characteristic obligation of self. We have not given much of our attention to Woman's Rights. We have never been an advocate—and indeed, we have had our indignation worked up to quite a fearful pitch, at the spectacle represented at these female conventions—the unadvised ebullience and ranting which sometimes prevailed. Yet from a consideration of so much of the subject as we have given, we cannot but justify their claims to entire equality in so far as the exercise of the right of franchise goes. Nay, if our premises be worth anything, the conclusion is inevitable, that if there is a superior fitness for the exercise of that right.—Elmira Republican.
