THE DRAFT IN THE 16TH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT.—We learn from the York Press that the draft for the Sixteenth Congressional district, composed of York, Cumberland and Perry counties, will be made at Carlisle, commencing today or to-morrow.

PROVOST GUARD IN CARLEISLE.—Company D, of the 51st Pennsylvania militia, (Captain Clegg), has been detailed as a Provost Guard for Carlisle. The company was raised in Manayunk, Philadelphia, and contains quite a number of gray haired men, who would scarcely be able to stand the hardships of the field.

AGAIN IN OPERATION.—The railroad bridge along the line of the Cumberland Valley road have been re-built, and the train which left the depot this morning was to run as far as Shippenburg. The train advertised to leave at four o'clock this afternoon, runs the whole length of the road, and will reach Chambersburg for the first time since the rebels had possession of that town, in June last.

ENLISTED AS PRIVATE.—The Lancaster Fencible band arrived in town this noon, and are now in Camp Curtin. We understand that every member of the band, numbering seventeen, has enlisted in Company H, of the 79th Pennsylvania regiment as a private, and are now here as recruits for the 4th regiment. They will probably be detailed by the Colonel as musicians after they reach the regiment, and thus maintain their old organization, besides doing service in the field.

THE GOOD WILL PICNIC.—The committee appointed by the members of this company, have decided to hold their picnic at Fisher's woods, on Friday, the 24th inst. The picnic was advertised to be given on the 20th of June, but owing to the emergency then existing, it was postponed until next Friday. The picnic is to be held for the purpose of obtaining money to make another payment on their new engine, and for this reason we give them a notice in our local columns.

BECOMING SCARCER.—Considerable apprehension is felt for a supply of bivalves during the coming season. In Baltimore last season they were unusually scarce, and the prices went up about 25 per cent. The packers of Baltimore, in view of the information received from the lower part of the bay that the oysters are nearly exhausted where they have been taken for the past three years, held a meeting and sent agents down the Chesapeake to examine into and report the facts. They reported that the beds are almost entirely destroyed, and as yet they cannot go to the beds in the Virginia rivers. Added to the scarcity of oysters, fully half of the whole number of boats engaged in the trade have been destroyed since the war broke out, and it has become difficult to get caught and brought to Baltimore the oysters that are left in the beds. In view of this condition of things, the packers of that city have declined to make any contracts at any specific terms.

THE FALLEN PENNSYLVANIANS AT GETTYSBURG.—By a dispatch from Chambersburg, we learn that every arrangement has been made at Gettysburg, by Governor Curtin, for the removal, on application to David Willis, residing there, of the bodies of the Pennsylvanians killed in the late battle. A map of the battle-field has been made which shows the exact locality of every grave. A list of the wounded and sick Pennsylvanians is also being made, and every facility for the finding of soldiers will be afforded. The trains, however, for the next eight days, will be used exclusively for the transportation of the wounded and sick. Persons who contemplate a visit to Gettysburg for the purpose of removing the remains of relatives and friends, would do well to postpone it for one week at least. Transportation will be furnished at the State expense for the body and one person to accompany it. Those of the Pennsylvania militia wounded in the late skirmish near Hagerstown will be returned to their homes as soon as the transportation can possibly be procured.

SERIOUS RAILROAD ACCIDENT.—Last Saturday, as a train of cars were passing over the new bridge, recently erected over the Conowing creek, near York Haven, on the Northern Central railway, the locomotive and several freight cars broke through the bridge. The locomotive did not appear to have sustained much injury by the accident, but the cars were completely wrecked. The engineer and fireman were injured, but not dangerously. The conductor, William Kinn, from this city, was seriously injured, though he is now doing well. One of his legs was crushed at the ankle, and had to be amputated. Three demolished freight cars were loaded with fat hogs and sheep, most of whom were either killed or drowned. The bridge (or trestle work) was erected by the government construction gang to supply the deficiency created by the old one being swept away, and had not been sufficiently strong enough for the passage of heavy trains. The bridge has since been repaired, together with the other bridges along the road, and travel resumed as usual.

HOME AGAIN.—The 16th Pennsylvania

militia, passed through the city this morning, on their way home to Pittsburg.

REMOVED.—Brigadier General Jos. E. Kiefer, of this city, has been relieved from duty in this State, and was to leave for Washington at four o'clock this afternoon, from thence to proceed to the Army of the Potomac, to join his old brigade in the field.

FROM GETTYSBURG.—The train from Baltimore this morning had a car attached containing twenty-one dead bodies from Gettysburg. They were all packed in neat pine boxes, and plainly directed to their places of destination. Several of the deceased were from Ohio, and had belonged to the regiments organized near and in the city of Cleveland. A majority of the bodies were accompanied by their friends, who had come on to recover them and take their remains home for interment.

A HANDSOME PRESENT.—Captain R. I. Dodge, commanding this post, was presented with a handsome meerschaum pipe, last Saturday evening, the gift of several U. S. Army and State officers, now stationed in this city. The present, which took place in the parlor of Brant's Hotel, was made on the part of those interested by Capt. J. K. Clement, Provost Marshal. The response of the Captain was brief but eloquent, and loudly applauded. The whole ceremony was filled with interest, and was made more so by the amusing and pleasing incidents related by the Captain and his friends. The pipe, which was selected by Lieut. Opsyke, of this city, is a beautiful one, costing \$35.

GEN. THOS. A. ROWLEY, commanding the 3d division of the 1st corps, in the recent three days' fighting at Gettysburg, was in town yesterday, on his way to Pittsburg, he having received leave of absence for twenty days. In the first day's fight his division lost 1,786 men out of 2,693, and in the other two days (the 2d and 3d of July) he lost 210 men, thus reducing it to 700 rank and file—scarcely a regiment in actual strength. He lost one aid killed, and two wounded. Gen. Rowley, besides being a brave and skillful officer, is a most excellent gentleman, whose return home safe and sound will be welcomed by hundreds of devoted personal friends. Allegany county may well be proud of such men as Rowley, Hayes and other heroes of the late splendid victory.

ASSAULT AND BATTERY.—Another case of assault and battery was up before Alderman Kline on Saturday afternoon. Lawrence Shlip, living in Verbetoketown, was charged with assaulting and battery by a neighbor, Mrs. Sophia Beltz. It appears that while Mrs. Beltz was engaged in washing clothes in the yard back of her house, Shlip, without any just cause or provocation, insulted her by uttering vulgar epithets, but not being satisfied with words only, he climbed over the fence into the yard, and struck her on the face. Yet Shlip was not satisfied by striking her, and re-entered his house only to appear in a more threatening manner, with a pistol in his possession, intending to shoot the defendant. The weapon was taken out of his hands, however, before he could use it, and he was escorted to the Alderman's office by Mr. McClintock, lately an extra policeman of this city. Shlip was committed for trial.

RELEASED.—Two ladies reported to Capt. R. I. Dodge, on Saturday, for transportation to their homes, having been taken prisoners at Winchester, Va., at the time Milroy was driven from the place, and since released, when they managed, through some inconvenience to reach this city. One of the ladies was from Union City, Ind., and the other from Wheeling, Va. After their capture they were taken to Richmond and placed in Castle Thunder, where they were confined until exchanged. One of the ladies, on her arrival in this city, was so overcome with over exertion and fatigue that she could not walk to the office to receive her transportation home, though she managed, in company with her companion, to reach the cars going west, and is, by this time, near her home in Virginia. The ladies fully confirm the report of the arrest of many others, with themselves, without any pretext whatever, who are still in the rebel prison waiting to be exchanged.

THE GOVERNMENT BAKERY.—This establishment, recently erected in this city by order of the Government, is nearly completed, and will be started to-morrow for the first time. The bakery is the largest of the kind, we believe, in this State, containing eight large sized ovens, it is capable of turning out between 25,000 and 30,000 rations per day, and will, when in full operation, give employment to sixty-six bakers, though it is not probable that one-half that number will be necessary to furnish the rations for the troops in the vicinity of this city. The bakery was built under the superintendence of the Commissary of the post, Lieut. Col. Bell, and will be put in operation by the superintendent of the bakeries at Alexandria, Va., Mr. Z. Jones. The buildings used for baking purposes in Alexandria, are among the most extensive ones in the United States, and are capable of turning out many more thousands of rations a day than the one in this city. The cost of the Harrisburg bakery will be, when completed, over \$5,000.
