SAFETY OF MAJOR GREENAWALT.—We are pleased to state that Major Greenawalt of this city, supposed to have been lost on the steamer Ruth, is safe. He was not on the Ruth, having remained over at Cairo the night before the accident, but followed on the "City of Alton" early the next morning. The "City of Alton" passed the burning wreck, but not knowing what it was, went on to Memphis, where Major Greenawalt learned of its loss, and returned to Cairo shortly afterwards in consequence.

PRETENDED OFFICERS DEFEATING THE GOVERNMENT.—It has been discovered that extensive frauds have been perpetrated upon the Government in Philadelphia and elsewhere, by men pretending to be army officers, and presenting forged pay rolls at the offices of the direct paymasters. One individual, representing himself as a Major in the volunteer service, is alleged to have obtained over seven hundred dollars from a paymaster in Philadelphia, and a considerable sum in Baltimore and New York. He was arrested and held in custody.

THE CITY PROTEST GUARD.—Among the many bodies of men which volunteered their services to the State, this summer, none have been more efficient than the First Battalion of Pennsylvania volunteers, now acting as a Protest Guard in this city. They have never failed in the line of their duty, and the order and peace which pervaded the city at the time so many troops were here is mainly due to the usefulness of this battalion. In the battle on two companies from Philadelphia, one of which was recruited in the "City of Works." Lieut. Colonel Joseph F. Bames, of Montgomery county, commands the battalion, and the Adjutant is Thomas E. Little of Philadelphia.

SERIOUS ACCIDENT.—An accident occurred in North street, near the Capitol grounds, about eleven o'clock this morning, when a man named John Young, was very seriously injured. It seems that Mr. Young, who lives in Liberty street, between Second and Third, was driving a horse attached to a loaded cart, along the street, when the animal became frightened and attempted to run away. He tried to check his horse, but as he was doing so, he fell and a wheel of the cart passed over him, breaking his collar bone, crushing his breast, injuring his head internally, and in such a manner as to cause the blood to flow copiously from both his ears. He was carried into the Capitol grounds, and attended by Dr. Miles, who pronounced his injuries to be of a very serious nature. He was conveyed to his residence, in Liberty street.

AN ARMY OFFICER ON THE DRAFT.—A prominent officer in the regular army writes in a private letter: "We must learn that a man who shoulders his musket is not doing a favor to the country as the volunteer sees it, but obeying a right which the Government has, and to sacrifice every drop of American blood, if necessary, and then call for the women when the husbands have died. We must learn that of our nation's duty done before, in a far more glorious cause, and that the conscript is more the soldier in every sense of the word, than the bravest volunteer that ever drew breath. "I should like to have had a regiment of drafted men, for, with proper treatment and good organization, they can be brought on a par with even our regular army."

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPOSING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION. Be it resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That the following amendments be proposed to the Constitution of the Commonwealth, in accordance with the provision of the tenth article thereof: There shall be an additional section to the third article of the Constitution, to be designated as section four, as follows: SECTION 4. Whenever any of the qualified electors of this Commonwealth shall be in any actual military service, under a requisition from the President of the United States, or by the authority of this Commonwealth, such electors may exercise the right of suffrage in all elections by the citizens, under such regulations as are, or shall be, prescribed by law, as well as if they were present at their usual place of election. There shall be two additional sections to the eleventh article of the Constitution, to be designated as sections eight and nine, as follows: SEC. 8. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature containing more than one subject, which shall be clearly expressed in the title, except appropriation bills. SEC. 9. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature granting any powers, or privileges, or in any case, where the authority to grant such powers, or privileges, has been, or may hereafter be, conferred upon the courts of this Commonwealth.
