





An Episode of the Battle of Volturno.

THE DARING AND DANGERS OF GARIEALDE

A correspondent of the Journal des Debits says: The most brilliant episode of the action says: The most brilliant episode of the action of the 1st of October was the recapture of the battry at the foot of Mont Sau Augelo. Garl-baldi arrived at bine o'clpck, when the enemy was thundering at it with all bis strength be-cause it took him in flank, and was causing him severe has. The triple battery couragonaly resisted the attack, and never slackened fire, when all at once the one situated at the foot of the hill became client. the hill became silent. The royalists, to the number of 2,500, got round the hill, and rushing upon the guns spiked five of them, and killed several of the men at t eir pieces. Gar-ibaldi, on the San Tammaroside, soon observed. the ellence of his favorite battery, and an aid-de-camp from General Milwitz soon informed him of the disaster, which would prohably have lost him the battle. Garibaldi at once have lost him the battle. Garibalin at once started off, crossed Santa Maria, followed by Medici and his staff, and, collecting, what men, he could, cried out in a volce which caused all to shudder, "We are going to die, but the Italians must win the day; at all other points we have conquered." Followed by 100 men, at a rapid pace, Garibaldi, leading the way in a small disabled carriage, went right forward.— But just as they got near the Casino of San An-gelo, some Neapolian Chasseurs who were lying on the ground rose and fell on them.— The coachinan drove his horses into a ditch, and formed a barricade of the carriage. Gari-baldi jumped up, Indignant, and went up to the Chasseurs, shouting "Viva Italial" Sime of his men coming at ithe same time, the enemy became demoralized, and took to flight. Garibecame demoralized, and took to flight. Gari-baldi was slightly wounded in the stomach, and bis trowsers were riddled by two or these bullets.
