Harrisburg, June 22, 1861

In accordance with the provisions of the sixth section of the Act passed the 15th of May, 1861, entitled an Act to create a loan and provide for arming the State, the Governor, Commander-in-chiet, makes the following rules and regulations relating to the organized state. regulations relating to the organized staff of the military force of this Commonwealth now or hereafter to be called into the service of this State or the United States.

I. The commander of the regiment will appoint the Acquaint from the subalterns of the regiment. He will also appoint the non-com-missioned staff of the regiment. He will nominate the regimental Quarter Master from the subalterns of the regiment to the Governor

II. In cases of vacancy, the commander of a regiment may make a temporary appointment of Quarter Master.
