From Washington.

The Rebel Batteries on the Potomac. THE STEAMERS MOUNT VERNON AND PAWNEE FIRED AT. SIX SHOTS TAKE EFFECT. MISSION OF SHIDELL AND MASON. RELEASE OF REBEL PRISONERS. EFFECT OF THE NEWS OF GEARY'S VICTORY AT WASHINGTON. Deaths of Pennsylvanians at Washington.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 17. The steamer Mount Vernon, Capt. Mitchell, came up the river last night. Some twenty shots were fired at her from the batteries at or near Shipping Point, but none struck her.

Capt. Mitchell reports that thirty or forty vessels bound up with Government stores and merchant vessels with coal and oysters are lying at Smith's Point afraid to attempt passing the enemy's batteries near Shipping Point. There are three batteries there mounting thirteen or more guns.

A battery has just been opened at Quantico Hill on the right bank of Quantico creek, a short distance above Shipping Point. The other three are between Shipping Point and Evansport.

There is said to be also a battery at Timber creek and one gun on the hill above Evansport. When the Pawnee and Mt. Vernon went down night before last the Mt. Vernon preceded the Pawnee and the four hundred men on board were ordered to lie down on deck two deep in passing the enemy's batteries, which was done and they thus escaped observation from the shore.

Thirteen shots were fired at the Pawnee, six of which struck her and one passed near her magazine. The Aquia Creek battery is silent. The steamer Alger is at the Navy Yard taking in stores.

Information has been received here from a source entitled to credit that Shidell and Mason, the rebel ministers to France and England, are not only authorized to negotiate treaties of extraordinary commercial advantage with those powers, but to place the Southern Confederacy for a limited period under their protection.

Of the thirty-six rebel prisoners to be released according to the recent special order, only three of them to-day took the oath of allegiance, namely: George Larrabee and Joseph Elliott, of Maryland, and Jeremiah O'Brian, of Georgia. The others took the oath not to bear arms against the United States.

The news of Col. Geary's dashing and successful fight at Harper's Ferry, causes much rejoicing here. Major General Banks is here to-day. There is much speculation about the probability of his crossing the Potomac at Harper's Ferry, now that Geary has demonstrated practically that it can be done.

The rebel batteries on the Potomac need not deter transport steamers from sailing from northern ports for this city, as they will be conveyed from the mouth of the river by war steamers. Thirty vessels are below the batteries this morning, which will soon come up. The batteries have, thus far, fired into no transports.

The Government, some time ago, made a large purchase of blankets for the army. The Government has seized a vessel laden with produce at Baltimore, from the eastern shores of Virginia.

J. L. Foreman, Jacob Snyder, and Joseph Frew, of the Thirty-third Pennsylvania Infantry, and W. Speck, of the Third Pennsylvania Cavalry, have died in the hospital here.

Secretary Cameron did not arrive this morning from the West, as expected.

THE EFFECT OF SECRETARY SEWARD'S CIRCULAR IN NEW YORK. New York, Oct. 17. The circular of Secretary Seward caused a depression in stocks to-day, especially in government securities, it being supposed by some that the Secretary of State was in possession of knowledge relative to foreign movements which prompted the issuing of such a document. Government 6's of 1881 declined about 2 per cent., and some leading stocks fell off nearly four per cent. The noon market, however, closed slightly more steady.

LATER FROM COL. GEARY.

CAPTURE OF A NUMBER OF PRISONERS. They Report the Rebel Loss at 150 Killed and Wounded. COL. GEARY SLIGHTLY INJURED.

FOUR OF ROCKS, Oct. 17. Col. Geary, with a part of the force under his command, achieved a glorious victory yesterday at Bolivar, on the Virginia side of the Potomac, against a greatly superior force of cavalry, artillery and infantry, capturing a 32 pounder and some prisoners, who reported a loss of not less than one hundred and fifty killed and wounded. Our loss was only four killed and seven wounded—one mortally, and one missing. Col. Geary was slightly wounded with a shell. The fight lasted five hours.

BURNING OF KEROSENE OIL WORKS. New York, Oct. 17. The Kerosene oil works of J. H. Brudering, at Hunter's Point, were burnt this morning. Two men were fatally injured. The loss is estimated at \$10,000.
