

The confiscation bill was taken up. Mr. STOWE, (Wis.) was in favor of the con fiscation bill and the punishment of the rebels, but he thought the bill before the Senate was not worth the paper it was printed on. He contended that we had no authority to pass such a bill, and ought not to have such auoct4'61-daw17 and if they commit any more they shall be stripped of their property.
