The Verbeke Rifles—List of Killed and Wounded.

Correspondence of the TELEGRAPH.
HEAD QUARTERS, 1st BATT. 2d ARMY

killed, wounded and missing of Company D,
(Verbeke Rifles) 48th Reg't Va. Vol., taken from
the official regimental report.

Clearly upon those who have brought this
great calamity upon their fellow citizens.
It should not be borne by taxation of the
whole municipality, because the madding and
working men have never been heard at the
ballot box, unshowered by threats and unmenaced
by threats and paid assassins of conspirators
against peace and good order. Beside, more
than the vote which was claimed for secession
have taken the oath of allegiance to the United
States.

The United States Government does its share
when it protects, defends and preserves the
people in the enjoyment of law, order and
calm quiet.

Those who have brought upon the city this
destruction of business, this desolation of the
heart of home, this starvation of the poor, and
helpless, should, as far as they may be able,
relieve distressed.

There are two classes who it would seem pe-
culiarly fit should at first contribute to this
end. First, these individuals and corporations
who have aided the rebellion with their means;
and, second, those who have endeavored to
destroy the commercial prosperity of the city,
upon which the welfare of inhabitants de-
pends.

It is brought to the knowledge of the Com-
manding General that a subscription of \$1,250,-
000 was made by the corporate bodies, business
firms and persons whose names are set forth in
schedule "A," annexed to this order, and that
sum placed in the hands of an illegal body
known as the "Committee of Safety," for the
treasonable purpose of defending the city
against the Government of the United States,
under whose humane rule the city of New Or-
leans had enjoyed such unexampled prosperity,
that her warehouses were filled with the trade
of all nations who came to share her freedom,
to take part in the benefits of her commercial
superiority, and thus she was made the repre-
sentative mart of the world.

The stupidity and watchfulness with which
this immense sum was spent was only equalled
by the folly which led to its being raised at all.
The subscribers to this fund, by this very act,
betray their treasonable designs and their abil-
ity to pay at least a much smaller tax for the
relief of their distressed and starving neighbors.

Schedule "B" is a list of cotton, brokers,
who, claiming to control that great interest in
New Orleans, to which the world is made tributary
for her wealth, published in the newspapers in
October, 1861, a manifesto deliberately advising
the planters not to bring their produce to the
city, a measure which brought ruin at the same
time upon the producer and the city.

This act, sufficiently testing the malignity of
the traitors as well to the Government as
their neighbors, and it is to be regretted that
the inability to relieve their fellow citizens is
not equal to their facilities for injuring them.

In taxing both these classes to relieve the suf-
fering poor of New Orleans, even though
the needy be the starving wives and children
of the traitors, it is not only just, but it is
impossible to make a mistake save in having the assess-
ment too easy and the burden too light.

It is therefore ordered—
First—That the sums in schedules annexed,
marked "A" and "B" set against the names
of the several persons, business firms and cor-
porations therein described, be and hereby are
assessed upon each respectively.

MESSAGE OF GOV. MAGOFFIN.

FRANKFORT, Aug. 15.
Governor Magoffin's message to the State
Legislature condemns the invasion of the State
by John Morgan; and says the Southern Rights
men disapprove of it. He reviews the present
position of the Federal Government, regrets the
arrest of citizens without legal process, recom-
mends the adoption of the Crittendon resolu-
tions as a standing proposition of peace and set-
tlement; and, at the close, says:

"I hazard nothing in saying that I have been
more untiring in my honest efforts to preserve,
and have made more propositions to prevent a
secession of the Union (and which promised to
be successful if they had been adopted in time),
than all of my busy, traveling calumniators,
who had their own vile purposes to
serve."
