FROM TENNESSEE. Recapture of Clarksville, Tennessee, by Federal Troops from Fort Donelson. LOUISVILLE, Sept. 9.

Colonel Preston, of the Eighth Kentucky Cavalry, has just arrived from Russellville, and reports that on Sunday evening a portion of General Grant's forces from Fort Donelson drove a body of rebels, consisting of three hundred guerrillas with about one hundred and fifty citizens of Clarksville, from their retreats at Providence, three miles from Clarksville.
