THE NEW COMET .- The position of the new comet, discovered at the Cambridge Observatory on the 18th ult., is nearly on a line joining the bright and first magnitude star Capella with the Northstar, and two-thirds of the distance from Capella to the North star. Capella can be seen at 1134 P.M., in the northeast, near the hori-zon. The comet is rapidly approaching, is AT LEMAN'S RIFLE WORKS, increasing in brilliancy, and will soon be readily seen by all.
