THE LEGALITY OF TREASURY NOTES SUSTAINED.

District Court—Judges Sherwood, Hare and Stroud—Merrine vs. Sailor et al. This case, which has been before reported on the two occasions in which it was before the Court, is an important one to the many ground-rent landlords in this city. It arises in this way: The plaintiff conveyed to the defendants a lot of ground in 1839, reserving a ground rent of \$570, lawful silver money of the United States, each dollar weighing 17 penny weights and 6 grains at least.

Destructive Fire at Oil City.
Pittsburg, April 9.
About midnight on Wednesday a fire broke out in Oil City, on Main street, below the Post Office, which destroyed a block and a half of buildings.
