The Release of Our Fleet
From General Sherman.
THE POTOMAC ARMY.
Its Condition Better than it Has Ever Been
Our Armies Reinforced.

Washington, May 23, 1.35 P. M.
Major Gen. Dix, New York.
"Dispatches from Maj. Gen. Canby dated at the mouth of the Red river at midnight, May 15, state that Admiral Porter has just arrived and that the remainder of the gunboats will arrive to-night.
"Gen. Banks will probably reach Sempronis on the 24th inst. to-day.
"A dispatch from Admiral Porter dated on board the flagship Black Hawk, at the mouth of Red River, May 16th, states that the portion of the squadron above the falls at Alexandria have been released from their unpleasant position, owing to the indefatigable exertions of Lieutenant Colonel Bailey, acting engineer of the Minnesota Army Corps.
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
