There is a steady demand for wheat, and prices are looking up; sales of 2,800 bushels of red at \$1.80 @ 1.88, and 8,300 bushels of white at \$1.80 @ 1.88. Corn is in steady demand, and 8,000 bushels yellow sold at \$1.59 spot, and \$1.66 @ 1.67 in store. Oats are steady at 87 @ 88c. A sale of shipstuffs at \$35 @ 36 ton. There is a firm feeling in provisions, but not much doing. Sales of hams in salt at 16c per lb, in pickle at 14c @ 17c, smoked. Sides at 14c @ 14c, and shoulders at 13c @ 14c. Cattle at 50 to 60c head at 16 cents cash, now held higher. In naval stores and oils no change. Whisky is rather quiet; sales of Pennsylvania and Ohio barrels at \$1.39 @ 1.34, and drudge at \$1.30 @ 1.31.
