Do not use the drops when forbidden in the directions, for although a positive cure, and harmines it all other times, they are so powerful and finely calculated to educate and govern the functions of the sexual erganism, that, at taken at improper times, they would produce results constrary to nature, against which all, particularly these who would reproduce, should carefully guard.

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
