Attention is especially directed to sections 4th, 5th and 6th, to wit:

880. 4. That every dog going at large within the limits of the said city, from the twentieth day of May until the twentieth day of September, in each and every year, shall have securely put on a good, strong, substantial and safe wire basket muzzle, inclosing the whole mouth of said dog, so as effectually to provent him from biting and snapping.
