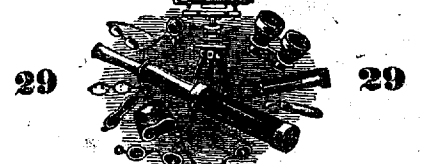

THE SECOND CORPS.

HEADQUARTERS, IN THE FIELD, August 28.
Since the battle of Ream's station nothing of particular importance has transpired in the Second corps. The number of missing is being rapidly reduced by the arrival of soldiers who had been scattered through the woods. The command is being reorganized, and new guns procured for those batteries which had pieces captured. Several stands of colors fell into the enemy's hands, because successive color bearers were shot down. In the One Hundred and Forty-eighth Pennsylvania—a regiment which distinguished itself on former occasions—the color bearer and color guard refused to leave their post in the intrenchments, and the colors were captured only after those brave fellows had fallen gloriously on that memorable day.

DEATH OF CAPTAIN DODD.
Captain Charles E. Dodd, recently assigned to General Hancock's staff as an assistant adjutant general, has passed away from the scene of action. It was not his fortune to fall on the field of battle, like the lamented Brownson. Captain Dodd was universally esteemed as a valuable officer and an accomplished gentleman.

IMPORTANT CIRCULAR.
Vessels Passing Spanish Ports
Must Show their Colors.
The Queen and Our Government

WASHINGTON, Aug. 31.
The State Department is in receipt of an official circular from the Spanish Government, introducing some favorable modifications of the rules observed at the fortress Tarifa and Isla Verde, to oblige vessels navigating the jurisdictional waters of these fortresses to hoist the flag of their nation, a practice which they often neglect, alleging a very probable ignorance in vessels which so repeatedly pass the Straits of Gibraltar.
