Letter from Washington, No. 8. Washington, D. C., Feb. 14, 1849.

Great preparations are in train here for the reception of Gen. Taylor, the President-elect, which will be on the 20th instant.

Messrs. Wendell and Van Benthoeyen, the printers elected to execute the printing for the Thirtieth Congress, having failed to perform their contract at the prices agreed for, proposals for printing for the next Congress, were opened on the 7th of February, by the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House.

The most important measure, perhaps, of the present session, is the introduction into the Senate of a Bill, by Col. Benton, providing for the construction and location of a great "Central National Railroad."
