A Brush with the Rebels. Special dispatches to the Evening Post and Commercial report, that one of the Government coast guard steamers got ashore last night at the mouth of the Potomac, and was attacked by an armed procler from Richmond, with a large force of the rebels. After a brisk contest, the rebels were repulsed. Their loss is unknown. Four United States soldiers were killed and five wounded. The latter were landed at Fort Washington to-day. Another steamer with fifty soldiers has gone in pursuit of the rebels.
