CINCINNATI, Jan. 21. A special Louisville dispatch to the Commercial, says that dispatches received at Head Quarters announce that the battle took place on Sunday morning, and that General Thomas continued the pursuit until night. Our forces followed the rebels, who ran before them like a flock of frightened sheep close up to their entrenchments on the north bank of the river.
